WHAT IS LSM?

Leadership Southern Maryland (LSM) was founded in 2008 to nurture interest, regional knowledge and leadership capacities of Southern Maryland leaders while educating them on the challenges that face the region. LSM is THE place where connections are made in the region – Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary's counties. Your participation results in important and valuable relationships—peer-to-peer, business-to-business—all in the context of great fun and learning while seeking to improve the region

WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM INCLUDE?

Each year the *accomplished and diverse leaders* from the three counties are selected by a group of their peers to participate in a *stimulating and thought-provoking nine-month tuition-based educational program*. The program is intense; however, the results are rich and rewarding. Class members converge for a series of one- or two-day sessions from September through May as well as for activities related to their class project. The sessions include programming throughout the region on *Southern Maryland's most significant issues*: energy, environment, defense, public safety, housing and human services, education, economic and workforce development, healthcare, multiculturalism and diversity.

WHAT ARE THE OUTCOMES?

LSM, when reviewed closely, is a meaningful opportunity for individuals to **reflect** on the importance of leadership, differing opinions and perspectives, to **build** rewarding relationships and to act on networking and community trusteeship to **make a difference** in their communities.

LSM seeks applicants who are:

- ✓ Mid- to high-level leaders with significant career and community achievements
- ✓ Willing to support the efforts of the organization after graduation
- ✓ Willing to commit the time, energy, and resources necessary to actively participate in and complete the program
- ✓ Representative of the diversity of our region in profession, geographic location, age and gender, ethnicity, business sector
- ✓ A resident or employee in Southern Maryland
- ✓ Concerned about the future of Southern Maryland and personally committed to help shape its future

TUITION

If selected, you will be invoiced for tuition, which covers program expenses. Tuition is \$3,800 (check) or \$4,100 (Visa or MasterCard) by August 15, 2017 (postmarked). If paid after August 15, 2017, tuition is \$4,100 and must be paid-in-full by check or credit card by September 1, 2017 (postmarked). Payment plans may be arranged. *Need-based scholarships are available.*

Applications are online at www.leadershipsomd.org and are accepted from February 1 through April 1, 2017. The interview and selection process concludes by July 1, 2017.
