Executive Program Highlights

ORIENTATION RETREAT

On September 14 & 15, 2020, the Class of 2021 began its Executive Program journey with a two-day orientation retreat at Holiday Inn Solomons in Solomons, Maryland. Led by facilitator Dr. Blair Brennan Slaughter, MBA, PhD, the class participated in a number of thought-provoking discussions including the critical roles of trust in leadership and servant leadership in moving communities forward. The retreat also featured a presentation on regional economics by renowned economist Anirban Basu and a small groups discussion with commissioners from Charles and St. Mary's counties.





ECONOMIC & WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

LSM's Class of 2021 explored Economic and Workforce Development in Southern Maryland on October 1. The day opened with a panel discussion featuring the economic development directors from Calvert, Charles, and St. Mary's counties (Kelly Robertson-Slagle LSM'10, Darrell Brown, Chris Kaselemis). The class also explored concepts like creating entrepreneurial communities and "getting Southern Maryland back to work" after the easing of restrictions brought on by the pandemic. The latter portion of the day focused on workforce development with virtual tours of The Charles County American Job Center and the JobSource Mobile Career Center. The class also received a briefing on soft vs. hard skills.

HOMECOMING

LSM Homecoming went virtual on October 1, 2020. Graduates from far and near gathered together to "meet" the newest class and toast the Class of 2020, the "longest class ever." The month-long LSM "Gives Back Challenge" was launched and grads were encouraged to donate items to local food banks and schools or give time, talent, or dollars to any organization of their choosing. The Class of 2021 had the highest level of participation and was crowned the "Most Giving Class Ever!"





DEFENSE & INDUSTRY

On November 5, the Class of 2021 delved into the topic of Defense. Class members spent the morning aboard Naval Air Station Patuxent River where they received a brief on the United States Naval Test Pilot School followed by a tour of the flight line. The class also went on a windshield tour of the base with stops including Atlantic Test Range, the Environment Department Conservation Division Education Center, and the air traffic control tower.

The afternoon was spent getting an up-close look at EOD robotics with several members taking up the controls and operating the robots. This was followed by briefs from local advocacy groups who champion both the base and members of the military along with a presentation on Readiness and Environmental Protection Integration.

MULTICULTURALISM & DIVERSITY

After a 3-month pause, LSM resumed programming for the Class of 2021 Executive Program with the Multiculturalism & Diversity session. Guided by facilitator Dr. Blair Slaughter, class members explored stereotypes, discussed "Leadership of Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion," and engaged in small group conversations exploring a variety of topics related to the day's theme.

PUBLIC SAFETY

Public Safety was the focus for the April 1 Executive Program session. The class received a brief on 911 call center operations and training practices, got up close and personal with several fire apparatus and watched a variety of demonstrations including a vehicle extrication. During the lunch break, emergency personnel were on hand to discuss a wide range of topics like human trafficking and Calvert County's mobile crisis team initiative. The class also interacted with the three Southern Maryland sheriffs and watched several police demonstrations including K9 and drone teams in action. They finished out the day with a visit from Trooper 2, getting an in-depth look at the helicopter and its personnel's mission and capabilities.





EDUCATION

The Class of 2021 experienced education in Southern Maryland on May 13. The day began with panel discussions with regional educators and students who shed light on the challenges and successes of teaching and learning during the pandemic. The program session also featured Southern Maryland leaders in education, including all three superintendents from the tri-county area as well as the presidents of both College of Southern Maryland and St. Mary's College of Maryland. This allowed for discussion of critical topics including school funding, teacher retention, and how community members can better support education. That concept was fine-tuned during the day's final presentation on internship opportunities and partnerships in the region.



ENERGY & ENVIRONMENT

April 29 and 30 were dedicated to the exploration of Energy and Environment in Southern Maryland. The Class of 2021 toured the Marlay-Taylor Water Reclamation Facility, getting an overview of Metcom's operations and learning about the wastewater treatment process. They also heard from representatives from Exelon's Calvert Cliffs Nuclear Power Plant and Southern Maryland Electric Cooperative (SMECO), giving them an overview of energy production in the region and insight into the organizations' leadership structures.

On day two, the class experienced "commerce in action" at the Loveville Produce Auction. They also visited Farming 4 Hunger where they had an opportunity to learn about the farm's origin story, mission, and daily operations. The class participated in several team-building activities to help them gain a fuller understanding of the impact of the organization and its programs on a larger scale.



HEALTHCARE

Healthcare was the focus for the Class of 2021 at the session held on June 3. The event spotlighted representatives from the three area hospitals in a panel discussion on healthcare issues and challenges in Southern Maryland, particularly during the COVID-19 crisis. The class participated in a mental health first aid exercise, a dementia awareness activity, and met with the health officers from the tri-county area to learn more about public health challenges and programs in the region. The session also expanded on the COVID-19 response in Southern Maryland and how leaders across multiple industries including public safety, healthcare, and education have worked together to navigate obstacles presented by the pandemic.

HOUSING & HUMAN SERVICES

On June 24, the Class of 2021 participated in the final educational session of their program – Housing and Human Services. The group learned about how adverse childhood experiences can affect one's ability to thrive. They received an overview of housing in the region and took a closer look at housing and human services via presentations by United Way Charles County and the Southern Maryland Family Advocacy Center. How the class, as leaders, can help with issues facing Southern Maryland and beyond was a focus for the session, culminating in a volunteer opportunity with the ARC of Southern Maryland. The class members wrapped up their day with a networking event at Running Hare Vineyard.

after three years with the company, progressed through all levels of management, and now serves as vice president of the engineering business unit. His division consists of approximately 1,200 personnel and represents \$300M of annual revenue.



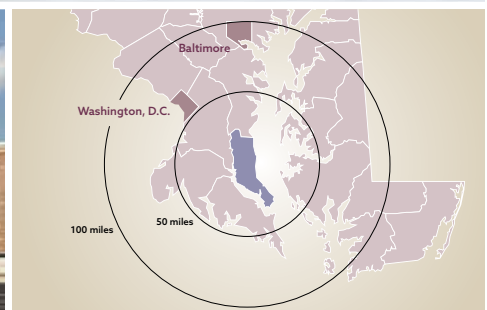
